## Downtown LA Art Walk to be held monthly

> Gallery Row Organization, a group of downtown Los Angeles art venues, will host Downtown Art Walk on the second Thursday of every month from 12 noon to 9 p.m. A Downtown Art Walk will be held this month on November 11.

The Downtown Art Walk is a monthly, self-guided tour of the art exhibition venues in Downtown Los Angeles, which includes commercial art galleries, public museums, non-profit spaces, and grassroots arts venues. The boundaries of the Art Walk are the 101, the 110 the 10 Freeways and the Los Angeles River. This event is free and open to the public.

Participants include the Museum of Contemporary Art, the Museum of Neon Art, sixspace, Gallery 727, Bank Gallery, Bert Green Fine Art, Art Share, Milla Angelina Gallery, and others. The Downtown Art Walk is an opportunity for the public to familiarize themselves with this unfolding art scene in the area, as well as those venues that have been downtown for years.

The recent designation of Gallery Row on Spring and Main Streets from 2nd to 9th Streets has added additional energy to the downtown art landscape. On Gallery Row alone, an estimated 13 galleries are planning to open within the coming year. As these galleries come to be, they will be invited to join the Art Walk. Gallery Row joins the more established Artist District to the east, and the Grand Avenue cultural district to the west, as well as a number of other downtown arts institutions.
